The involvement of civil society in governance matters is gaining prominence internationally, to the extent that formal regulations prescribing the involvement of organised civil society in the affairs of local government have over time become common practice in many governments, including our own.

This places an enormous responsibility on local government to ensure that in the development and implementation of all plans, communities are taken on board in a manner that is not just cosmetic, but that is instead premised on the notion that the people themselves know best what is best for them.

In his opening address at the opening of the National Assembly in February this year, President Thabo Mbeki announced a *Volunteer Campaign*, which, in his words, aimed at "*strengthening the links and the cooperation between the government and the people*".

In response to the President's call, the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality urges all residents to become involved in the reconstruction and development of their communities through their ward committees.

## STRUCTURE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TSHWANE WARD COMMITTEE SYSTEM (WCS)

### **STRUCTURE**

**The WCS is made up of –**

- ward-based committees;
- sub-committees/portfolios to anchor the ward committees;
- an area-wide forum that brings all the ward committees in an area together; and
- a city-wide forum that ensures the involvement of stakeholders that are non-ward-based in matters of local government.

### **OBJECTIVES**

#### **Public involvement**

- To encourage all residents and stakeholders to become involved in the government of the city.

#### **Communication**

- To promote better understanding, interaction and relations between the people of Tshwane and their Municipality.

#### **Development**

- To be a vehicle for development.
- To review local statutes in partnership with all communities so as to introduce initiatives that result in development.

#### **Capacity building**

- To empower communities to contribute to a better-functioning Municipality.

## STATUTORY FRAMEWORK

### **NATIONAL**

The Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act 117 of 1998), and the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act 32 of 2000), provide the basis on which municipalities and the people in their care can become partners in the planning process.

### **LOCAL**

The Tshwane Council resolved to establish ward committees as the system to provide a mechanism for participative government. The Council set the following guidelines for the ward committees:

#### **a) Powers, functions and responsibilities:**

- Deal with all matters that affect and benefit the community.
- Act in the best interests of the community.
- Make recommendations to the Council on any matter affecting the wards.
- Ensure the participation of the community in the -
  - IDP process;
  - the Municipality's budgetary process;
  - decisions about the provision of municipal services; and
  - decisions about by-laws.

#### **b) Composition**

- Each ward committee is composed of not more than ten elected members from the different sectors of the ward.
- The ward councillor is the chairperson of the ward committee.

#### **c) Term of office**

- The term of office of the ward committee is two years.
- Members of the ward committee can serve a maximum of only two terms.

#### **d) Sub-committees and portfolios**

- Every ward committee decides on the types of sub-committees and portfolios it wants to have in its ward.
- Members of the ward committee are allocated specific sub-committees/portfolios to head up as their responsibility.
- All stakeholders in the ward are encouraged to participate in sub-committees that are relevant to their fields of interest and to their day-to-day functioning as a sector.
